### **WELCOME**

Kerry welcomed everyone to the meeting & the last meeting's minutes were approved.

### **TREASURERS UPDATE**

Current total available PTA funds are approximately £10,000 (£5000 has been put to one side to pay for Playground equipment & £2400 for Cameras -see Feb 09 minutes)

Highlights include:

- The KS2 disco generated a fantastic £429 in profit (giving £72 to Comic Relief).
- Ticket sales for Ricky's dance night doing well at £265 so far.
- £140 spent on the new Cheerleading Squads kit & pom-poms.
- Since the 1<sup>st</sup> October the PTA has raised £5000 to date, which is a fantastic effort bearing in mind we still have a number of events coming up, including the Summer Fete.

Debbie handed over another £500 matched funding cheque to add to the pot.

Mr Rose mentioned that he is arranging for a number of quotes for the Playground markings. There is a £1200 grant to help towards the cost of this, but he will shortly be putting in a funding proposal request to the PTA.

### **RICKY BROWN DANCE NIGHT**

Tickets are selling well. It was decided that sweets weren't to be sold, just crisps, pop & glow items. Sara said that she would donate 3 boxes of chocolates for adult prizes & Katie volunteered to get the toys'r'us voucher for the child's prize.

### **QUIZ NIGHT – Friday 15<sup>th</sup> May**

Lyn Jefferies is organising with John & Emma. Katie will meeting Brian Lawes (Band caller for the Barn Dance) to come & assess the room on the night of the quiz.

### **BARN DANCE & BBQ – Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June**

Katie is organising. Band & caller are booked. If the School BBQ can't be found, then Jill has kindly offered the use of her husband's rugby club's BBQ. Tickets will be on sale from 1<sup>st</sup> June. Cost of ticket was agreed at £3 per person. Debbie will contact Aubrey Allen to see what deal can be done on sausage & burgers.

Katie will e-mail Louise & Jane with details for the posters & Kerry will be printing tickets.

### **PAMPER NIGHT - Friday 26<sup>th</sup> June.**

Louise has contacted a number of organisations & individuals, who have agreed to help out at this event. There will be stalls & treatments on offer.

### **SUMMER FETE – Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> July**

Time decided 11.30-2.30. Mr Rose confirmed that the turf should be available on the school field for the fete & the Year 3 camp. As we are going for a 'Traditional' theme this year, Sara will speak to a Punch & Judy man that she knows of – to see whether it would be suitable for our fete. Edy has said that she doesn't mind running the kitchen again to include cream teas, strawberries etc. Sub-meeting will be arranged to discuss stalls for the fete.
