### **TREASURERS UPDATE**

Current total available PTA funds are approximately £11,200.

Summary of recent movements include:

- Quiz night generated a profit of £213..
- £2200 spent on cameras for the children
- £2700 given to the school to purchase the new playground benches & bins.

As previously mentioned in April's minutes there is a £1200 grant to help towards the cost of the cricket, netball court & hopscotch playground markings. The PTA agreed that we would contribute a further £5000 to help fund the rest of the school's playground markings. It was also agreed that all remaining fundraising events proceeds (for this school year) should also go towards funding the playground markings.
