Job Opportunities

The school is seeking to employ the following staff:

- **Walking Bus Leaders** to organise and supervise children walking to school from the Burnt Post pub car park. This will involve meeting children at 8.30 am, starting the walk at 8.40 am and handing the children over to school staff at 8.55 am.

The rate of pay is £6.08 per day and applications are welcome from people who can work the full week or only part of it.

- **Lunchtime Supervisory Assistants** to work with / supervise a child with special educational needs during their lunch break. The hours are 11.50 am to 1.20 pm, and the rate of pay is £7.51 per hour.

Norovirus (Winter Vomiting Disease)

The school nurse has advised us that there are between 60,000 and 1 million cases of this in England each year. In order to guard against an outbreak in school we have spoken to the children about the importance of good hygiene and have provided anti-bacterial soap for them to use.

However, should your child be unfortunate enough to suffer from sickness or diarrhoea they should stay off school while these symptoms persist and for two days afterwards as they are still likely to be carrying the infection for this period of time.
