Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Talk about how they and others show feelings, talk about their own and others' behaviour, and its consequences, and know that some behaviour is unacceptable.

Confident to try new activities, and say why they like some activities more than others.

Takes steps to resolve conflicts with other children, e.g. finding a compromise.



Literacy

Know that information can be retrieved from books and computers.

Read and understand simple sentences. Attempts to write short sentences in meaningful contexts.

Use their phonic knowledge to write words in ways which match their spoken sounds.

Write some irregular common words.

Physical Development

Shows some understanding that good practices with regard to exercise, eating, sleeping and hygiene can contribute to good health.

Understanding the world

Know about similarities and differences in relation to places and living things.

Talk about the features of their own immediate environment.

Completes a simple program on a computer. Uses ICT hardware to interact with ageappropriate computer software.

Communication and language

Develop their own narratives and explanations by connecting ideas or events.

Ask and answer 'how' and 'why' questions about their experiences and in response to stories or events.

Listen to stories, accurately anticipating key events and respond to what they hear with relevant comments, questions or actions.

Mathematic

Orders two or three items by length or height. Orders two items by weight or capacity.

Use everyday language to talk about size, weight and capacity to compare quantities and objects and to solve problems.

Using quantities and objects, they add and subtract two single-digit numbers.

Expressive Arts and Design

Explores what happens when they mix colours. Understands that different media can be combined to create new effects.

Manipulates materials to achieve a planned effect. Represent their own ideas, thoughts and feelings through design and technology, art, music, dance, role play and stories.
