R.E.

Focus is looking at Sacred books across different religions and Easter.

Music

Using Charanga to look at rhythm, pulse and beats in reggae music.

Computing

Using google earth to find locations and use Beebots to learn about debugging programs.

P.E.

Gymnastics skills and Real PE.

Art

Focus Artist: Lowry. Looking at art work of urban landscapes. Creating artwork of the local area in the style of Lowry.

Geography

Drawing a map of a familiar area/route. Looking at different maps of the local area and identify differences from the past. Learning about map keys and finding different symbols on maps.

Science

Identify the needs of humans for survival. Identify simple differences between living and non- living things. Introduction to the sequence of the human life cycle. Compare differences and changes from babies to children.

Mathematics

Geometry - direction and movement, symmetry, repeating patterns.

Time- Units of time, reading the time to the nearest quarter of an hour on an analogue clock, solve a range of time problems.

Addition and subtraction- focus on two digit numbers with exchange.

History

Investigating changes of our local environment. Looking and investigating the changes of Stivichall Primary school and the history of local significant figures. Investigating old and new houses. Investigating and identifying how shops have changed.

Literacy

The Lonely Beast by Chris Judge: Understanding of reporting through role play, interviewing and gathering information. Structure of newspaper reports to progress to writing their own newspaper article. Practising writing factual information in chronological order, including opinions and writing in the past tense.

Guided reading

The Queen's hat and Paddington Bear. To develop inference, comprehension and vocabulary skills.

Phonics Revision of phase 5 and spelling rules. Spelling, grammar and punctuation e.g. commas, suffixes, verbs, adverbs, homophones.
