Number and place value - we will be counting on and back in ones, tens, hundreds and thousands from any given number. We will read, write and partition 4 digit numbers.

We will compare and order amounts and then solve number problems.

Written addition and subtraction - add 2 or more three and four digit numbers using a formal written method.

We will be using a formal method to subtract three and four digit numbers with exchanges.

Science
