This half term we will be learning all about the topic of "Paws, Claws and Whiskers".

## Other areas of learning

- As **Scientists** we will we will be learning about animals and their features.
- As **Geographers** we will be learning about maps and plan perspectives.
- As **Design Technologists** we will be making animal puppets.
- As **Artists** we will explore animal prints through the art work of Andy Warhol.
- In **Computing** we will understand how to log on to laptops and start using computer programmes independently.
- In our learning about **PSHE**, we are celebrating our differences.

## Mathematics

Areas covered this half term include:-

- Continuing to learn numbers bonds for 10, 20 10s, 2s, 5s for the Knights of The Times table challenge which will take place weekly.
- Measuring - We will be developing vocabulary and knowledge of time.
- Comparing and ordering numbers using place value.
- Addition and subtraction using the counting on and back method.

We will continue to embed our knowledge of number and shape, space and measure through problem solving and everyday examples. This term we are also setting Mathletics activities online for your child.

## Reading and Writing

We will be looking at the following types of genres and text;

- Animal Story (Description of animals. habits and habitats)
- Non-Chronological reports
- Our Power of reading text this term is The Emperor's Egg.

We will continue to apply our phonic knowledge in our writing.

- Write narratives, using sentences that make sense including clear finger spaces.
- Continue to develop the use of conjunctions to extend our sentences such as; because, so, and.
- Working on our cursive letter formation.
- Focus on using a range of punctuation- Capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks.
- Learn basic grammar rules.

## Phonics and Spelling

Your child will have daily phonics or spelling lessons where they are taught phonemes and tricky words to enable them to segment (break down) and blend (put together) the sounds to read words.

## Guided Reading

Your child will be listened to in their guided reading group at least once every week in School. At this time we have other reading based activities to further embed their phonic skills and comprehension knowledge.
