Industrial Action

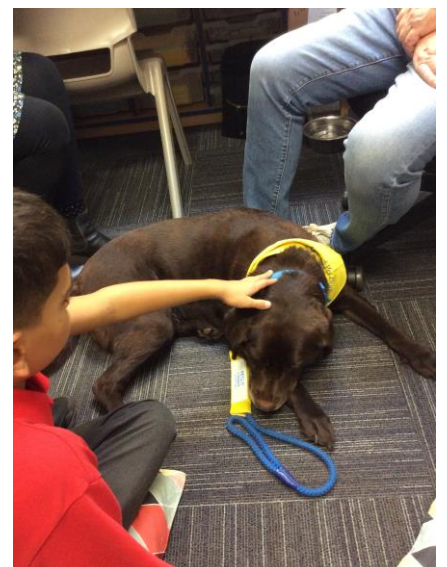
