National Test of the New Emergency Alert System on Sunday, 23rd April

The government's new emergency alerts system is live and will enable people to be contacted via their mobile phone when lives are in danger. The system will be tested nationally on Sunday 23rd April 2023 at 3pm.

An emergency alert is a loud, siren-like sound with a message on your mobile phone or tablet screen.

King Charles Coronation

As shared via ParentMail and Seesaw earlier this week, the Lord-Lieutenant of West Midlands, Sir John Crabtree OBE, has invited schools to join in with celebrating the Coronation of King Charles III, by designing sustainable bunting to decorate their school grounds.

Thursday, 4th May – Local Elections

As you are all aware, local elections are taking place on Thursday, 4th May and we want to advise you that the Rainbow Room, at the top end of the KS1 playground, will be used as a polling station as in previous years. The area will be fenced off

Accordingly. The Gregory Road entrance will not be in use for access to school on this day as this will be used for voters only. Please use either Green Lane or Coat of Arms Bridge Road at the start and end of the day on this day. As is normal practice, staff will be on the playground at all times whilst children are outside during playtime, lunchtime and any outdoor lesson time during the school day between 9.00 – 3.20 pm.

ID Required: A reminder that the UK Government has introduced a requirement for voters to show photographic ID when voting at a polling station. This new requirement will apply for the first time in Coventry at the local elections on **Thursday 4th May 2023**.

Safeguarding Reminder – 'Nut-Free' School

A reminder that in order to safeguard a child who has an extremely sensitive allergy to nuts, we would like to ask ALL parents for their support in making Stivichall a 'nut-free' school. This will mean that no nuts can be brought to school by any children, parents or staff, in packed lunches or snacks, including in nut 'spreads' such as Nutella and Peanut Butter/paste and bars such as Buenos. We really do appreciate your full support on this — even close contact with another child who has consumed nuts that day can result in a severe reaction (potentially life threatening) for this child. Thank you.

Early Bird Session

Our next Early Bird session is on Friday, 28th April. Pupils are invited to bring their parent/carer into their classroom from 8.30 am, when the doors will be opened, to share and celebrate their learning and achievements so far this term. All parents will be requested to leave at the start of the school day at 8.50 am. It can be to look at work, to look at the displays, to read a book – whatever you and your child want to do together. Please note the visit is confined to your child's classroom for safeguarding reasons. If a parent needs to go to another class, they will need to walk around the perimeter. If you have more than one child in school, you will need to split your time between the different classes or alternate sessions.


