

Godiva Festival

As you are aware, this year's Godiva Festival takes place from Friday, 30th June to Sunday 2nd July and the enormous amount of work to set up for the event has already started. This work is likely to increase next week causing more congestion in Coat of Arms Bridge Road at times. Impending Strike Action
