Bikeability Year 5 in Spring Term

The City Council are offering to deliver Bikeability training during the first half of the Spring term. The course is primarily aimed at teaching children how to ride confidently and safely on the road. It will run for 5 weeks starting on Thursday 11th January 2024 ending on Thursday 8th February 2024. It will take place during the school day with children out of class for 1.5 hours at a time. The cost will be £12.50. If your child does not have a roadworthy bike and a helmet to take part, the Local Authority maybe able to loan one for the duration of the course, please contact the school in the first instance to make us aware.
