Vaisakhi Celebrations

Vaisakhi will be celebrated this Saturday the 13th April. Vaisakhi is celebrated by Sikhs all over the world and marks the birth of the Khalsa. On this day in 1699, Guru Gobind Singh Ji established the Khalsa – the collective name given to baptised Sikhs.

On Vaisakhi, Sikhs go to the Gurdwara in the morning for a service. Afterwards, they have a procession through the streets with lots of singing, chanting and colourful clothes. The procession is called the **Nagar Kirtan**. This will take place on Sunday 21st April 2024 leaving from the Guru Nanak Parkash Gurdwara at 10am. In the evening, Sikhs have a special meal with family and friends.

We hope all our families enjoy their celebrations.

Safeguarding Reminder – 'Nut-Free' School

A reminder that in order to safeguard children who have an extremely sensitive allergy to nuts, we would like to ask ALL parents for their support in making Stivichall a 'nut-free' school. This will mean that no nuts can be brought to school by any children, parents or staff, in packed lunches or snacks, including in nut 'spreads' such as Nutella and Peanut Butter/paste and bars such as Buenos. We really do appreciate your full support on this – even close contact with another child who has consumed nuts that day can result in a severe reaction (potentially life threatening). Thank you.

This week's top eco tip: Limit showers to two minutes to save water (Jaan, 4S)


Reading with Nessie
