School Reminders:

As the weather warms up, please ensure your child has the following in school:

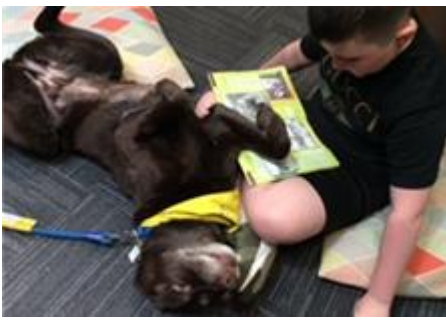
